

Rutland Water is home to the first Ospreys to breed in England for 150 years. 1348922 was one of the first Osprey chicks to be brought from Scotland by the Rutland Osprey Project. It successfully migrated to Africa, but unfortunately was captured there in its first winter. Another one of the 'Scottish' chicks of the same year is 03/97 nicknamed 'Mr. Rutland' by Simon Barnes of *The Times*.
